### "WET" SEEDS

Have an aril or a fleshy covering or just do not tolerate drying out.  
Sow ASAP or keep moist in recloseable plastic bag with a bit of sand or spagnum.

Arisaema triphyllum (jack in the pulpit)  
Cardamine douglassii (mountain cress, toothwort)  
Chrysogonum virginianum (green & gold)  
Cimicifuga racemosa (black cohosh)  
Clematis texensis  
Clematis viorna (leatherflower) seed head  
Delphinium alabamicum (alabama delphinium)  
Enemion biternatum (Isopyrum biternatum, false rue anemone)  
Geranium maculatum (wild geranium)  
Hepatica rotundiloba (round-lobed hepatica)  
Hexastylis arifolia (evergreen ginger, little brown jugs)  
Hymenocallis caroliniana (spiderlily)  
Jeffersonia diphylla (twinleaf)  
Polemonium reptans (Jacob's ladder)  
Sanguinaria canadensis (bloodroot)  
Spigelia marilandica (Indian pink)  
Stylophorum diphyllum (wood poppy, celandine poppy)  
Tiarella cordifolia var. collina (wherryii's foamflower)  
Trillium luteum (yellow)

### "DRY" SEEDS

*Aster family and phlox species are not self fertile. You must have two or more seed grown plants to get fertile seeds.*

Baptisia alba (white wild indigo) B. bracteata (cream wild indigo)  
Camassia scilloides (wild hyacinth)

Echinacea angustifolia & E. simulata (coneflowers) - Asteraceae  
Erythrina herbaceae (coral bean) - Fabaceae  
Gentiana saponaria (soapwort gentian)  
Heuchera macrorhiza (giant alumroot)  
Liatris earlii (gayfeather) - Asteraceae  
Lilium spp.  
Lobelia cardinalis (cardinal flower)  
Parthenium integrifolium (wild quinine) - Asteraceae  
Passiflora incarnata (passion vine)  
Penstemon calycosus (smooth beardtongue)  
Phlox paniculata (garden phlox)  
P. divaricata (wild blue phlox)  
Sarracenia leucophylla (white-topped pitcher plant)  
Silene virginica (firepink)  
Silphium asteriscus (rosinweed) - Asteraceae  
Symphyotrichum georgianum (georgia aster) - Asteraceae  
Zephyranthes atamasco (atamasco lily)  
Zizia aurea (golden alexander)
